Parks Committee Regular Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, February 4, 2026, at 6:00 PM

City Commission Chambers – 105 S. 2ND Street, Flagler Beach, FL 32136

Present: Chairman Tim Davis, Vice-Chairman Edward Lansdowne, John Timmins, Kathleen Conrad, Amanda Tully, Sue Eichler, Parks and Recreation Director Tom Gillin, CRA Director Casey Ryan, and Deputy City Clerk Colleen Kuhn. Project Manager Todd Anderson, Guest.

Absent: City Manager, Dale Martin and Diane Cline

1. Call the meeting to order

Chairman Davis called the meeting to order at 6:13 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Davis led the Pledge.

3. Approve Minutes

a. Approval of January 7, 2026, Meeting Minutes

Kathryn Conrad motioned to approve the January 7, 2026, meeting minutes. Amanda Tully seconded the motion. Motion carried.

4. New Business

a. Palmetto Park Package - Chairman Davis

Chairman Davis said Playground World looked at the park and found problems with the existing equipment and proposed new equipment that would work well in this area. He noted the items and quotes were included in the Committee's meeting packet. Todd Anderson, Project Manager, shared that he had obtained quotes for the equipment, shipping, and installation and provided documentation for the Committee to look over. Discussion about the equipment, quotes, ground cover, and City funding ensued. Casey Ryan, CRA Director, indicated that staff would get clarification on the amount of City funding for this project. Amanda Tully offered to research ground cover options and costs. Chairman Davis said he would investigate playground border options and costs. The Committee agreed the topic should be added to their March meeting agenda and they should come prepared to make a recommendation during that meeting.

The Agenda moved to Item 4d.

b. Palmetto Park Request - John Timmins

Mr. Timmins referenced an email he sent on January 29, 2026, requesting the City install a slab of concrete inside the fence at Palmetto Park for kids to draw on with chalk or play hopscotch. The Committee discussed the idea and Mr. Timmins said he would obtain price quotes and have them ready to be considered at the March meeting. Mr. Anderson said the Committee should consider safety around the play equipment, expressing that a hard surface could pose a hazard. He suggested an option like posting a chalk board in the area for kids to use.

c. City of Flagler Beach Programs/Events - Kathleen Conrad

Kathleen Conrad referenced her conversation with Mr. Martin, reporting the City Attorney advised him the Committee should not move forward with the tutoring program. She suggested holding events such as an Italian

Night, or a Dinner Dance Auction to raise money for the parks. She shared ideas for low-cost events such as a puppet show for kids. Discussion about event options and timing ensued. Ms. Ryan said City staff would be available to assist the Committee and suggested putting together a list of event options to consider at the March meeting. She supported the idea of the Committee participating in or leading the Trunk or Treat event.

- d. Special Event Ordinance; Road Closure, Waiver of Fee, and City Co-Sponsorship Requirements and Proposal by Corvettes at the Beach - Tom Gillin/Casey Ryan

Ms. Ryan reviewed the Special Event topic. She noted that applicants of the Corvette Club were there to present information on their proposed Corvettes at Beach event.

Greg Norton, Flagler County Corvette Club, explained the Club held their show in Flagler Beach for many years and said they would like to bring it back to Flagler Beach. He noted the show usually included about 150 cars and the attendees would bring business to the community. He reviewed a map of proposed road closures and shared approval of the event was time sensitive. Discussion about the event and impacts of road closures ensued.

Edward Lansdowne moved to recommend that the City Commission approve the event and the proposed road closures. Chairman Davis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Agenda returned to Item 4b when Item 4d was completed.

5. Old Business

- a. Grant and Project Information on Silver Lake Park

Discussion on this Item occurred during 5b Update on City Parks

- b. Updates on City Parks

There was discussion regarding the status of Wickline Park including the playground, volleyball courts, and timelines. Mr. Anderson said the same company would be working on the parking lot improvements and demolition at Wickline Park Playground. He noted that demolition at Palmetto Park could be carried out in a few hours. Chairman Davis asked about the status of Silver Lake Park, specifically trash removal and clearing by the road for safety and visibility. Ms. Ryan shared that the Management Plan for Silverlake Park was included in the Committee packet and said the park was intended to have more of a natural setting. She confirmed the City was responsible for maintenance and she would ask the Sanitation and Facilities Maintenance Departments to address the issues. Mr. Timmins shared he had purchased an 8' pole to replace a broken pole in Palmetto Park that was holding a no parking sign. There was discussion about whether locates were needed before the pole was placed. The Committee continued to discuss the status and condition of other City Parks.

6. Board Comments

Ms. Ryan shared that Board Game Night would be held on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month beginning February 11, 2026 at the Wickline Community Center, previously known as the Senior Center. The Committee shared updates on the Community Dinner and equipment rental.

Mr. Lansdowne asked about the volunteer who offered to help with the design of Veterans Park. Ms. Ryan said there would be a professional engaged to help with the park design at either a reduced rate or for free.

7. Public Comments

None

Adjournment

Ms. Conrad moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:56 pm. Mr. Lansdowne seconded. Motion carried.

What are Lowe's Community Impact Grants?

Lowe's Community Impact Grant program is part of Lowe's five-year, \$100 million commitment to renovating and restoring spaces that serve as hubs and heartbeats of our communities. Each year from 2022 through 2026, consumers are given the opportunity to nominate a community space in their hometown – such as a neighborhood garden, park or community center – to receive a physical renovation. Lowe's will select up to 100 projects per year to be completed by the nonprofit or community receiving the grant, in partnership with our Lowe's associates and community volunteers. In addition, Lowe's associates will roll up their sleeves to tackle more than 2,000 community improvement projects across the country through product donations and associate volunteerism.

What kind of projects are eligible?

Any type of project that involves the physical improvement or renovation of a community space is eligible. All grants must go to a local nonprofit, school or city/municipality that is willing and able to take on the project. Past nominations have included:

- Community Centers/Services (e.g. youth centers, senior citizen centers, veteran's centers, etc.);
- Safe Affordable Housing (e.g. homeless shelters, transitional living facilities, etc.);
- First Responder Facilities (e.g. fire stations, police stations, etc.);
- Community Revitalization (e.g. community park, community garden, renovations to downtown plaza, historic theaters, etc.);
- Skilled Trades Education initiatives (e.g. mobile training programs, high school vocational, etc.)

May I enter more than one project nomination?

You may nominate as many different projects as you like. Please do not enter more than one nomination per project. Nominating a project multiple times will not increase the likelihood of a project being selected.

Are rural or urban communities prioritized or weighted differently in the selection process?

No. The only factor considered related to geography is distance from the project location to a local Lowe's store. Lowe's will only select projects within 30 miles of a Lowe's store, to ensure we can properly provide the materials and volunteer support needed to complete the project.

How are grant amounts determined?

Can grant funds be used for labor costs, permits, or professional services?

Yes, grant funds can be used for labor costs, permits, professional services and materials to complete the project.
